

# Lake Washington Sailing Club 2008 Midwinter Regatta

The Lake Washington Sailing Club is hosting our annual midwinter regatta series on the fourth Saturday of the month on January 26th, February 23<sup>rd</sup>, and March 22nd. Lake Washington is the turning basin for the Port of Sacramento and one of the best places to sail in Sacramento with consistent breezes and friendly sailors. Our facilities include a clubhouse with a large deck, a launch ramp, and an eight hundred pound capacity hoist. This regatta is open to any centerboard sailboat 20ft in length and under.

## **Schedule for the Day**

9:00a.m.	Registration begins in the clubhouse
10:00 a.m.	Registration ends; Skippers' Meeting on the deck of the clubhouse
10:30 a.m.	Final classes posted
11:00 p.m.	First Warning
3:00 p.m.	Final race start deadline

**Entry & Fees** An early entry form is attached or available at the Lake Washington Sailing Club Website. The entry fee is \$10 US for each day. The entry fee covers all racing and regatta awards.

**Racing** Up to six, short-course races are scheduled for each day with the first warning at 11:00. Racing will be held under the 2005 to 2008 ISAF, US Sailing rules and the sailing instructions. The Racing rules will be changed as follows:  
44.2 - The two-turn penalty is modified to a one turn penalty.

**Scoring and Classes** Three boats should constitute a class and should receive a class start. All other boats will sail in open Portsmouth divisions.

Awards will be presented in each class after the last race of the series as follows:

Three to five starters	1 awards
Six to Seven starters	2 awards
Eight or more starters	3 awards
