Lake Washington Sailing Club Junior Sailing Camps

The 2013 LWSC Junior Summer Camps are designed for children age 8-15. There are two class levels.



Learn-to-Sail: This course teaches the basic sailing technique, terminology, and theory. It is designed for children who have little or no sailing experience. Learn-to-Sail classes are scheduled in the morning from 9:00-12:00 so the temperatures are cooler and the winds are lighter. Since we keep class sizes small, this class can be repeated.

Advanced Sailor/Racer: This class is for children who have two or more seasons of experience sailing and feel comfortable racing in close quarters against others. The participants work on racing skills such as tuning, starting, tactics, and advanced boathandling. Advanced/Racer camp runs from 1:00 to 4:00 pm.

Cost: Each three-day session costs \$100 per person. Payments and release/information forms are required on the Friday prior to the first day of camp.

Minimum Enrollment Policy: Class minimum size is three students enrolled by the Friday preceding the week of class.

Maximum Enrollment: Class sizes are limited to a maximum size of ten students.



Safety Requirements: All campers must be able to complete a swim test on the first day of class and must wear PFDs (Personal Flotation Devices) while on the docks or in boats.

What to bring: Campers should bring the following gear to class:
