



**2015 WEST SAC PORT REGATTA  
NorCal #9, February 28, 2015  
Notice of Race**

**Organizing Authority:** The Lake Washington Sailing Club (LWSC) is the organizing authority, in conjunction with PCISA and the NorCal League. LWSC facilities include a delta clubhouse with deck, restrooms, a launch ramp, and an eight hundred pound capacity hoist. [WWW.LWSAILING.ORG](http://WWW.LWSAILING.ORG)

**Location and Racing Area:** Lake Washington Sailing Club is located at the turning basin for the Port of West Sacramento. Exit Capital City Freeway (Business 80 / SR-50) at Harbor Boulevard south, then right turn onto Industrial Boulevard, and turn left across railroad tracks onto Boathouse Road south of 2901 Industrial Boulevard. In Google Maps, search for 3101 Industrial Blvd., West Sacramento, CA and follow Boathouse Road to the south. Look for LWSC signs.

The racing area for the Gold and Silver CFJ fleets will be announced at the Competitors/Skippers meeting the morning of February 28.

**Parking and Unloading:** Trailer unloading and loading will be allowed only in the lower parking lots. All CFJ tow vehicles and trailers will park in the upper parking lot. Coach boats and trailers will park in upper parking lot. Look for Parking Attendants for assistance.

**Launching and Dockage:** All boats must have minimum 15' painters or dock lines. All CFJ boats must be launched with hand dollies from NE and SW docks and tie up. Coach boats to 21' are allowed and may use the south launch ramp before 9:30 a.m. and raft up. Look for Dock Attendants for assistance.

**Racing Rules:** The RRS of 2013-2016 apply, as modified by the current ISSA and PCISA procedural rules, the provisions for 2014-2015 NorCal League regattas, and the sailing instructions (available race day). Coaching is allowed on the water or ashore in between races only. Coaches are not allowed in the race area during a race.

**Awards:** LWSC will award prizes to top three teams in Gold and Silver Fleets.

**Eligibility, Entry & Entry Fees, Registration:**

- Regatta is open to all High School Teams registers for the 2014-2015 PCISA season.
- Each team consists of 2 sailors who attend the same school.
- Each team must provide class legal CFJ, including sails with distinct NorCal assigned sail numbers.
- There will be no boat rotations.
- Each team will race in either Gold or Silver Division, predetermined by the teams' head coach.
- Entry fee is \$20 per competitor (checks payable to LWSC). \$10 for each additional meal.
- Fee includes continental breakfast and lunch.
- Enter by filling out registration form on the PCISA website or Regatta Network.
- Deadline to register is Friday, February 20, at 5 p.m. Contact LWSC (lwschsteam@gmail.com) directly for late registration.
