



**2016 Northern California District Thistle Championships
Notice of Race**

Saturday May 21, 2016

The Lake Washington Sailing Club (LWSC) will host the 2016 Northern California Thistle District Championship Race, Saturday May 21, 2016. Lake Washington is located at the turning basin for the Port of Sacramento. You can expect the afternoon delta breeze to be around 10-12 knots with an occasional 20 knot day. The cool delta breeze makes sailing at Lake Washington a welcome relief from the 100 degree temps that fry the rest of the Sacramento area, yet the warm water keeps the wetsuit in the locker. There really is no better time to sail at Lake Washington. Our facilities include a clubhouse with a large deck, restrooms, a launch ramp, and an eight hundred pound capacity hoist. There will be a BBQ after the race. We will provide the appetizers, BBQ chicken, salad, drinks and desert.

Who is Eligible to Race: Open to current TCA member with a registered boat. Only current Northern California District member's scores will be counted toward the NorCal District Championship.

Rules, Event Classification: This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016, Prescriptions of the US Sailing Association, the TCA Constitution and By-laws, the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

Racing: Weather permitting there will be a minimum of 5 races. Additional races will be run at the discretion RC.

Sailing Instructions: Sailing Instructions will be post on the LWSC website (www.lwsailing.org) no later than 2300 July 9, 2013.

Scoring and Awards: The Low Point Scoring, RRS A4 will be used.

- 1st place award for classes with total number of boats 1-4,
- 2nd place award for classes with total number of boats 5-9,
- 3rd place award for classes with total number of boats 10 and up.

Location: LWSC is located at 2901 Industrial Boulevard, West Sacramento 95798. After entering the gate travel approx. 25 yards and follow the paved road to the right to the end and turn right on to the gravel/dirt road to the parking area.
