

2023 One Design Championship Series Notice of Race

The Lake Washington Sailing Club invites you to our four-day One-Design Championship Regatta Series. The series develops one-design fleet and open class small sailboat racing.

Lake Washington is located at the turning basin for the Port of West Sacramento. Sailors can expect afternoon delta breezes of around 10-12 knots with an occasional 20-knot day.

Our facility includes a clubhouse with large deck, restrooms, dinghy ramp, concrete launch ramp, a 2000-lb. capacity hoist, and two-acre boat storage yard. These regattas are open to any centerboard sailboat or preapproved keelboat up to 21 feet in length.

Registration

Racing & Rules

Up to five races are scheduled for each day. The races will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing, as modified by the sailing instructions (available race day onsite and online).

One-Design Classes

Laser, Lido, Thistle, Sunfish, Flying Junior (Club), Banshee, Day Sailor, C-15, Windmill, El Toro, Hanse 303, and Open Classes

Two boats of the same design will constitute a class. The open class will be scored using the Portsmouth rating system. If you are interested in racing in a class not shown, please contact us.

Awards

Daily winners will be announced after the last race. Series winners are awarded at LWSC Annual Meeting. To be eligible for the One Design Perpetual trophy each fleet must field at least two boats on at least two regatta days.

<u>Location and Racing Area:</u> Lake Washington Sailing Club is located at the turning basin for the Port of West Sacramento. Exit Capital City Freeway (Business 80 / SR-50) at Harbor Boulevard south, then continue straight into driveway for Port (cross Industrial Blvd. and the railroad tracks. Turn right just before the Port entrance gate. Look for LWSC signs.
