1 RULES

- 1.1 The event shall be governed by:
- 1.1.2 World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) Windsurf Competition Rules (WCR).
- 1.1.3 The class rules of the participating classes will apply as amended by the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.1.4 Windsurfer Class: the Windsurfer fleet will compete using the International Windsurfer Class Rules. Older Windsurfer boards with soft sails < 6.0 are eligible to compete in the Windsurfer fleet. When sailing to windward, pumping is prohibited except for the first 30 seconds after the starting signal. Pumping is allowed at all times when sailing downwind.
- 1.1.5 Limited 7.5 Class: the Limited 7.5 class will be restricted 7.5 meter sail size maximum. When sailing to windward, pumping is prohibited except for the first 30 seconds after the starting signal. Pumping is allowed at all times when sailing downwind.
- 1.2 If there is a conflict between this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions will take precedence.

2 ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY

2.1 A Minimum of 3 competitors is required to constitute a division. Those entries accepted that

do not constitute a division may sail another division as defined by the race committee.

3 Classes and Divisions

- 3.1 The anticipated classes and divisions are:
- 3.1.1 Open Longboard
- 3.1.2 Windsurfer LT
- 3.1.3 Limited 7.5
- 3.1.4 Green fleet sailors with limited racing experience and sails 7.5 or smaller

4 FEES

- 4.1 The entry fee for adult competitors is \$20 if completed online prior to the regatta. A late fee of \$5 will be charged for those who do not register online prior to the regatta.
- 4.2 The entry fee for youth (under 18) competitors will be \$10 USD.
- 4.3 Late registration will be available onsite on the day of the regatta from 1:00 to 2:00 pm.

- 8.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 9.2(a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a board's score will be the total of her race scores.
- b) When 5 to 11 races have been completed, a board's score will be the total of her race scores

excluding her worst score.

9.1 Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the race committee.
